

Roman Chariot Race II

Equipment: Provided by each team, 5-2"x2"x6' and 1-2"x2"x8' wooden sticks, 8-8' lengths of sash cord.

Procedure: On signal, a unit of up to 8 lashes together a "chariot" in the form of a trestle frame, similar to the trestles used in bridge building: 3- 6' and 1-8' stick is lashed into a square shape and the fifth and sixth sticks are lashed diagonally to opposite sides, (see drawing below). When frame is finished, two Pathfinders lift up the chariot by the 8' stick and pull the chariot with a rider down the field down the field around a marker and back.

Scoring: Each team will be timed and their time stops when the team returns to the starting point with the chariot and rider intact. If the chariot comes apart or rider falls off they have to repair or get back on to complete the race.
